


1904 MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING



The International Football association Board met al Bangor (north Wales) June 11 1904 at 11 am under the Presidency of hus & DEdictures . Present Mesers & Didisbrug & J Davies (Wales) De Foy & I Sheehan (Ireland) & brunch & RP Sugar (Ingland) a Stevenson + R Dieon (Scotland) There were also present - Men J K Mc Dowall (Scottand) J Reid (Ireland) + W Hunnerley (Wales) minutes The minutes of meeting held at ayr were adopted Proposals. The following decisions with regard to the Laws were also adopted ; -Law 4 The whole of the ball must have passed over the goal-line or touch - line before it is out of play. The comer-flag must not be removed when a " 7 comer-kick is being taken. Wearing poft indiarubber on the coles of boots is L 11 not a violation of Law . 13 divesmen, where neutral, should call the attention of the Referer to rough play or ungentlemandy conduct, and generally assist him to carry out the game in a proper manner . It was resolved That all decisions of the International Board be printed at the foot of page, inclead of unmediately after the Law concerned hon The following resolution of the International Board of June 16 unded 1902 was rescuided; -" That any case of miscouduct on the part of club, flagers, or officials, which may occur in connection with any match, shall be dealt with by the association under whose Jurisdiction the match is played, and each association shall adopt
